



3.a Basic Steps to be remembered – CALL FOR PROPOSALS




Project Asks	TEIN*CC answers
TEIN*CC is to solicit proposals on a continuous basis from project partners.	 ✓ Carry out of 1-2 periodic call for proposals per year ※ Proposals submitted between calls will be respected and evaluated properly.
Any proposed activity under WP2, 3, 4 and 5 should have a regional dimension & must benefit by preference the DCI-eligible countries.	✓ Reflected on the evaluation criteria
For WP5 any proposed collaborations should leverage the Asi@Connect e-infrastructure aiming to generate wide societal/potential benefit.	✓ Reflected on the evaluation criteria

3.a Basic Steps to be remembered – requirement for a proposal




- A proposal at least should include the following.
 - ✓ Set of objectives
 - ✓ Expected outcome
 - ✓ Synopsis program
 - ✓ Target Participant(s)
 - ✓ Any other collaborations or related awarded projects or grants by other funding agencies
 - ✓ Outline of budget
- Standard templates will be posted and used starting from 2nd Call.


3.b Basic Steps to be remembered – EVALUATION structure



Project Asks	TEIN*CC answers
The advisory "Steering Committee" should assess and provide technical guidance on any proposed activities, including those coming from the "Governors' Meeting".	 ✓ SC is relevantly positioned in the Evaluation structure. ※ Independent Review Committee will be set up with a pool of professionals and experts knowledgeable and experienced on technologies, services and applications, in order to complement the evaluation quality.
For WP2, WP3, WP4, WP5 and WP6 the "Governors' Meeting" should discuss and reach consensus on the activities to be carried out.	✓ GM is relevantly positioned in the Evaluation structure
The final decision on activities to be carried out is taken by the contracting authority (represented by the EC project manager) in consultation with the project Coordinator (TEIN*CC).	 ✓ Reflected in the evaluation criteria ✓ TEIN*CC firstly filters proposals with the relevant criteria






Composition of Review Committee in case of 3 voting members



3.b Basic Steps to be remembered – EVALUATION criteria




- Aligned with WP objective and scope
- Promotion of usage of Asi@Connect (excl. WP6)
- Emphasis on the project's emerging/developing Countries
- Regional dimension and well structured methodology
- Quality of programs (e.g. effects on the developing countries and networks)
- Clear benefit for the community
- Potential for growth/further development
- Relationship with other existing projects at a regional/global level
- <u>Capacity of proposers</u> Demonstrates capacity to manage funds, conduct project activities and produce outcomes effectively, within the budget & time limits
- Visibility & PRs
- <u>Cost factors</u>, realistic budget and timeframe proposed
- etc. subject to opinions of Review Committee
- Awarded if the proposal scores equal or higher than 70

3.b Basic Steps to be remembered – other points to be noted




- Final amount to be funded and implementation period is subject to the result of evaluation.
- TEIN*CC can request applicants to provide more details and modify any part of the proposal (including the requested budget) at any time during the selection process.

3.c Basic Steps to be remembered – AGREEMENT




- Contract is signed between awardee and TEIN*CC
 - ✓ Standard template will be circulated and used
- The contractor is regarded in partnership with the TEIN*CC for the implementation of his/her proposal
 - ✓ It is ensured that some of the conditions applicable to the TEIN*CC will be also applicable to the contractors as follows.
 - All the supporting documents shall be available either in the original form, including in electronic form, or as a copy.
- Pre-financing could be requested

3.d Basic Steps to be remembered – Monitoring



- For effective management and dissemination of activity results, progress review and monitoring could be considered.
- Short-term programs (Implementation period less than 6 months)
 - ✓ final reports will be possibly reviewed by the evaluation committee who selected those activities.
 - * In case some members of the committee are not available at the monitoring stage, appropriate substitutes appointed by TEIN*CC, will take the relevant roles.
- Long-term programs (more than 6 moths)
 - ✓ both interim and final review could be considered
- Reward as well as penalty could be considered based on the results of the reviews.
 - ✓ If the review result is excellent, the awardee could receive some merits for future proposal. However, if the result is poor, the awardee could get some demerits for further program award.

3.e Basic Steps to be remembered – IMPLEMENTATION



- Any outputs/outcomes will be made available to the public and to the research and education community.
- Results/outcomes will be reported to the SC and Governors' Meeting for their review.
- Proper dissemination methodology such as case studies in the format of leaflets and posters will be considered.
